- 2. Summary of Application: Applicant requests a finding of reasonable diligence on the conditional portions of the Blue Valley Metropolitan District Pump and Pipeline and Blue Valley Metropolitan District 1998 Well Nos. 1 and 2 ("Subject Water Rights"). Applicant is a special district that provides water service to the residents within the Blue Valley service area.
- 3. Name of Structure: Blue Valley Metropolitan District Pump and Pipeline
 - Original Decree: Case No. 96CW286, entered on March 11, 1998, District Court, a. Water Division No. 5.

- b. <u>Subsequent Decrees Awarding Diligence</u>: Cases No. 11CW37 and 04CW42, District Court, Water Division 5.
- c. <u>Legal Description</u>: A well/infiltration gallery located in the NW1/4 SW1/4, Section 34, Township 1 South, Range 80 West of the 6th P.M. at a point 1,000 feet from the West line and 2,350 feet from the South line of said Section 34. This location is described in Well Permit No. 49622-F as being located in the NW1/4 SW1/4, Section 34, Township 1 South, Range 80 West of the 6th P.M. at a point 831 feet from the West line and 2,363 feet from the South line of said Section 34. See **Exhibit A** for a map depicting this location.
- d. <u>Source</u>: Blue River Alluvium, tributary to the Blue River, tributary to the Colorado River.
- e. <u>Appropriation Date</u>: August 1, 1996.
- f. <u>Amount</u>: 250 g.p.m., of which 167 g.p.m. is decreed absolute and 83 g.p.m. remains conditional.
- g. <u>Use</u>: Domestic water service for up to 150 residences, fire protection, municipal, irrigation of approximately 60 acres of lawn and landscape within the District's boundaries and within the West 1/2 of Section 27, and West 1/2 of Section 34, Township 1 South, Range 80 West of the 6th P.M, as depicted on the map attached as **Exhibit B**.
- h. <u>Depth</u>: approximately 20 feet.
- i. <u>Remarks</u>: The Blue Valley Pump and Pipeline is operated pursuant to Well Permit No. 49622-F and in accordance with the augmentation plan approved in Case No. 96CW286 and as amended in Case No. 98CW27.
- 3. Name of Structure: Blue Valley Metropolitan District 1998 Well Nos. 1 and 2.
 - a. <u>Original Decree</u>: Case No. 98CW027, entered on August 10, 1998, District Court, Water Division No. 5.
 - b. <u>Subsequent Decrees Awarding Diligence</u>: Cases No. 11CW37 and 04CW130, District Court, Water Division 5.
 - c. Legal Description:
 - 1. Well No. 1: A well located in the NW1/4 SW1/4 Section 34, Township 1 South, Range 80 West of the 6th PM, a distance of 777 feet from the West

- line and 2,454 feet from the South line of said Section 34, as depicted on the map attached as **Exhibit A**.
- 2. Well No. 2: A well located in the NW1/4 SW1/4 Section 34, Township 1 South, Range 80 West of the 6th PM, a distance of 740 feet from the West line and 2,546 feet from the South line of said Section 34, as depicted on the map attached as **Exhibit A**.
- d. <u>Source</u>: Blue River Alluvium, tributary to the Blue River, tributary to the Colorado River.
- e. <u>Appropriation Date</u>: November 14, 1997.
- f. Amount: 250 g.p.m., conditional, for each well.
- g. <u>Use</u>: Domestic water service for up to 150 residences, fire protection, municipal, and irrigation of approximately 60 acres of lawn and landscape within the District's boundaries and within the West 1/2 of Section 27, and West 1/2 of Section 34, Township 1 South, Range 80 West of the 6th P.M., as depicted on the map attached as **Exhibit B**.
- h. <u>Depth</u>: approximately 20 feet.
- i. Remarks:
 - 1. The cumulative diversions under any combination of the Blue Valley Metropolitan District 1998 Well Nos. 1 and 2 and the Blue Valley Metropolitan District Pump & Pipeline shall not exceed 250 g.p.m.
 - 2. The Blue Valley Metropolitan District 1998 Well Nos. 1 and 2 are operated pursuant to the plan for augmentation decreed in Case No. 98CW27.
 - 3. These wells are to be constructed within 100 feet from the river unless Applicant augments delayed impacts in an amount and upon a schedule acceptable to the Division Engineer.
- 4. <u>Integrated System</u>: In Cases No. 04CW42 and 04CW130, the Court confirmed the Subject Water Rights are part of an integrated water supply for Applicant's service area. "When a project or integrated system is comprised of several features, work on one feature of the project or system shall be considered in finding that reasonable diligence has been shown in the development of water rights for all features of the entire project or system." C.R.S. § 37-92-301(4)(b).

CLAIM FOR FINDING OF REASONABLE DILIGENCE

- 5. <u>Diligence Activities</u>. In the diligence period preceding the filing of this Application, Applicant undertook the following actions to complete the appropriation and beneficial use of the Subject Water Rights:
 - a. During the diligence period, Applicant evaluated improvements to the District's water supply system to achieve full buildout and increase service to additional customers.
 - b. Applicant issued a request for proposals in 2018 for engineering services to expand the pumping capacity of the Blue Valley Metropolitan District Pump and Pipeline. The selected engineering firm will also evaluate the feasibility of accommodating additional taps under the District's plan for augmentation and develop a current map of the District's water rights. The District anticipates selecting an engineering firm in July 2018.
 - c. Applicant extended service to additional customers; this included installing fifteen new taps and approving service to five additional taps. Applicant spent \$47,377 on the tap installations.
 - d. Beginning in 2014, Applicant worked with Alpine Survey to map the District's water-supply infrastructure. The map will simplify District repairs and maintenance and should be finalized in July 2018.
 - e. Applicant spent \$241,711 on substantial repairs to the District's system. Repairs included replacing the water main, several sections of service lines, valves, and conduits.
 - f. Applicant spent \$327,875 on the overall operation and maintenance of the District's water system. Costs include those associated with the District's certified water operators who maintain the service lines, test the water quality, and operate the District's water plant, water meters and hydrants.
 - g. Applicant engaged Balcomb & Green, P.C. to provide guidance on the use of its water rights and to monitor water court applications to protect the District's water rights from injury. Applicant spent \$6,329 on these legal services.
 - h. Applicant continues to rely on the Subject Water Rights and has no intention of abandoning them.
- 8. Name of owner of the land on which any new diversion or storage structure, or modification to any existing diversion or storage structure is or will be constructed, including any modification to the existing storage pool. Applicant.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the Court enter a decree finding that Applicant has been reasonably diligent in the development of the Blue Valley Metropolitan District Pump and Pipeline and Blue Valley Metropolitan District 1998 Well Nos. 1 and 2 conditional water rights.


